DESCRIPTION OF REQUIREMENTS

REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

1. The United Nations Organization Stabilization Mission in the Democratic Republic of the Congo ("MONUSCO"), seeks Expressions of Interest (EOI) from duly registered and licensed companies for the PROVISION OF GROUND SUPPORT SERVICES (Ramp Management, GPU Starts, Aircraft towing and Marshall ingredients), in Goma, Kalemie, Kinshasa, Kisangani and Lubumbashi, Democratic Republic of Congo .
2. MONUSCO will undertake a competitive bidding exercise shortly and accordingly intends to issue a Interest to Bid Request for Proposals (RFP) to those companies who would express their interest and provide initial relevant information demonstrating their ability to fulfill MONUSCO requirements. In addition, the interested companies will be requested to complete UN Vendor registration for level 2 on the vendor database accessible on ungm.org (new vendors only). A detailed Scope of Work (SOW) will be provided to companies short listed for receipt of the RFP documents.
3. The EOI should specify brief relevant information about the company including the company's profile, capacity/capability and experience. Vendors will be shortlisted based on their ability to provide the relevant documents showing that they are authorized to operate Aeronautics support services in DRC. Interested vendors must provide the following documents with their response:
 - Copy of the registration certificate / license(s) of the company
 - Valid permit to operate Aeronautics support Services from the Ministry of Interior and Security in DRC.Provision of expired permit will result in the rejection of your EOI.
4. Please note that this request for EOI is not an invitation for submission of a bid.

MONUSCO reserves the right in selecting the invitees for the competitive bidding based on substantial and proven records of performance in the subject field of activities and were submission of an EOI would not automatically warrant receipt of the RFP documents. La Mission de l'Organisation des Nations Unies pour la Stabilisation en République Démocratique du Congo (MONUSCO) sollicite des manifestations d'intérêt de la part des entreprises, dûment enregistrées et autorisées, pour la Fourniture Services de soutien au Sol (Gestion Ramp, GPU Démarre, remorquage des aéronefs et des ingrédients Marshall) à Goma, Kalemie, Kinshasa, Kisangani et Lubumbashi, en République Démocratique du Congo.
2. MONUSCO entreprendra un exercice de demande de proposition (RFP) et établira un document de

sollicitation aux sociétés qui auront exprimé leur intérêt et auront fourni des informations pertinentes initiales démontrant leur capacité à satisfaire les exigences de la MONUSCO. En outre, on demandera aux sociétés intéressées de s'enregistrer sur la base de données des fournisseurs des Nations Unies au "niveau 2" accessible sur le site ungm.org (seulement pour les nouveaux fournisseurs). Les spécifications détaillées seront fournies aux sociétés présélectionnées pour la réception des documents de sollicitation.

Les sociétés intéressées qui souhaitent recevoir le dossier d'appel d'offres sont invitées à soumettre par écrit une manifestation d'intérêt précisant en bref la capacité, l'expérience, le profil de l'entreprise dans le domaine de la fourniture de ce service de soutien aéronautique.
