


Figure 1. Percentage of violations per territory Figure 2. Number of violations per province in DRC North Kivu South Kivu The boundaries and names shown, and designations used on this map do not imply official endorsement or acceptance by the United Nations Masisi Shabundu Beni Uvira Lubero Bukavu Bas-Uele Rutshuru Kahele Butembo Mwenga Goma Fizi 67% North Kivu Walungu Djugu Kabare irumu Kasai Kamonia (Kas.) Mambasa Mahagi Kananga (Kas. C) Bunia Luebo (Kas.) Demba (Kas. C) Mbuji-Mayi (Kas. O) Tanganyika Kasai Oriental 1% Kalemie Mweka (Kas.) Nyunzu Tshikapa (Kas.) Moba Tshilenge (Kas. O) Kongolo Maniema Manono Kabambare 67% % by armed groups % by State agents

Figure 1. Percentage of alleged perpetrators





Figure 2. Percentage of victims and reported affiliation




