Figure 1. Percentage of victims of extrajudicial executions and arbitrary killings in conflict affected provinces

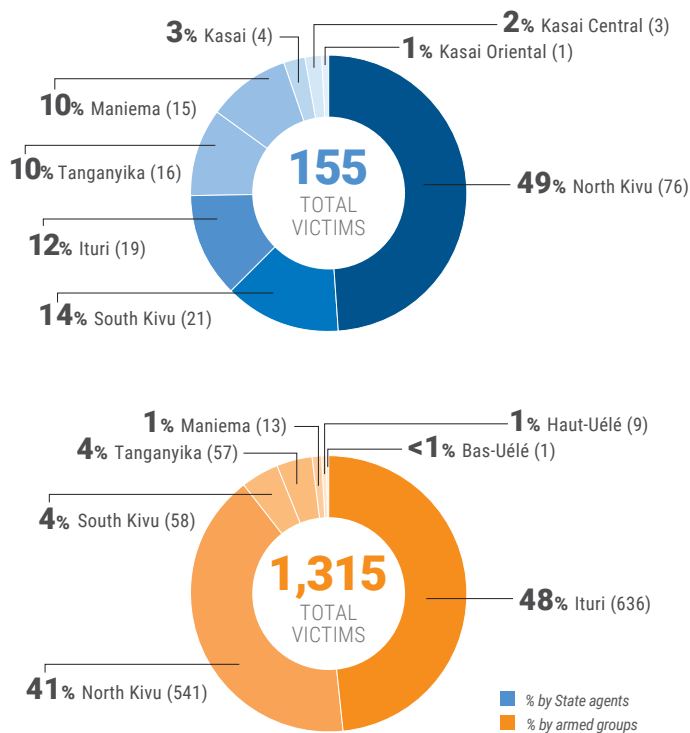


Figure 2. Number of violations per province in DRC

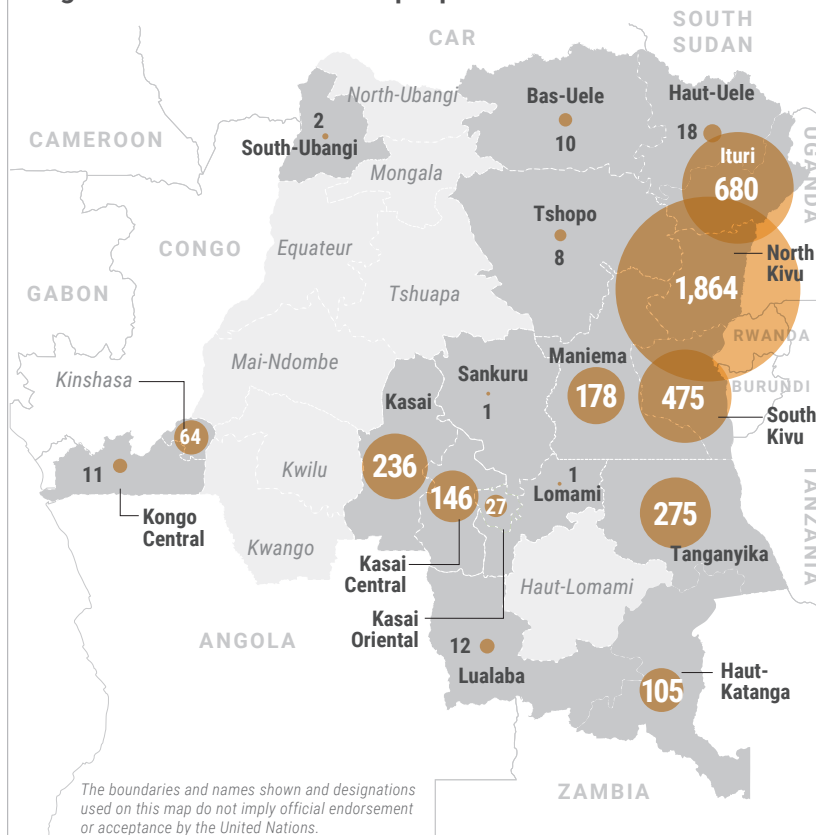


Figure 3. Reported violations per alleged perpetrator in all provinces

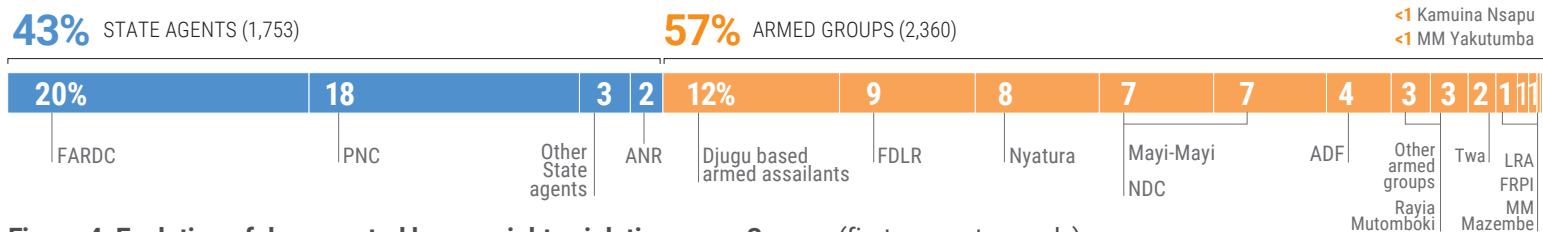


Figure 4. Evolution of documented human rights violations over 3 years (first semesters only)

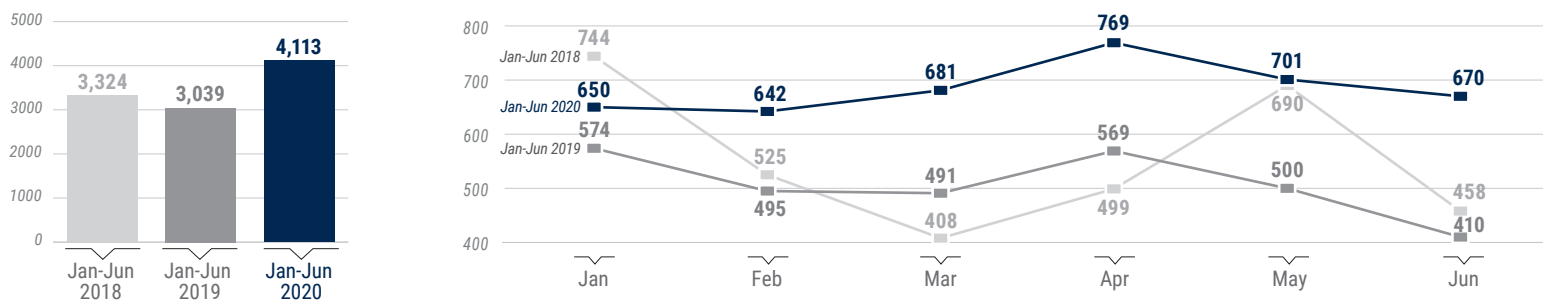
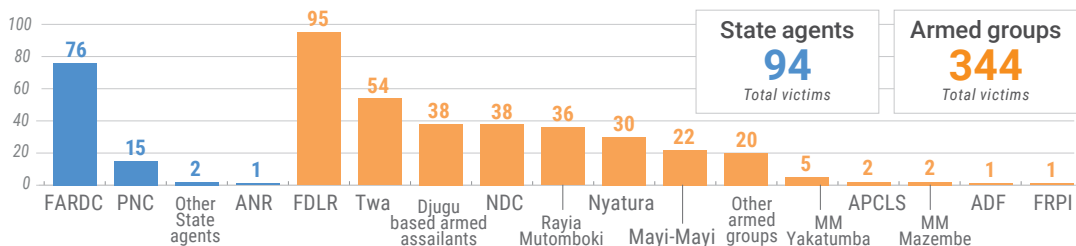


Figure 5. Number of adult victims of CRSV by perpetrators

Figure 1. Percentage of alleged perpetrators

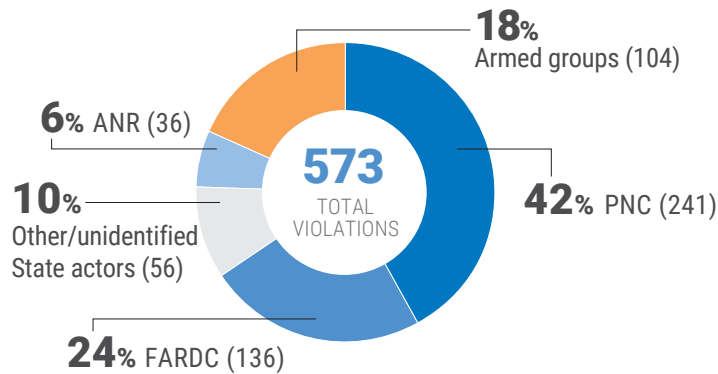


Figure 2. Percentage of victims and reported affiliation

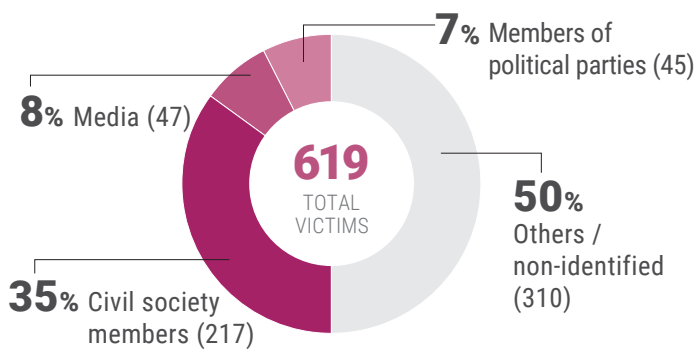


Figure 3. Number of violations per province in DRC

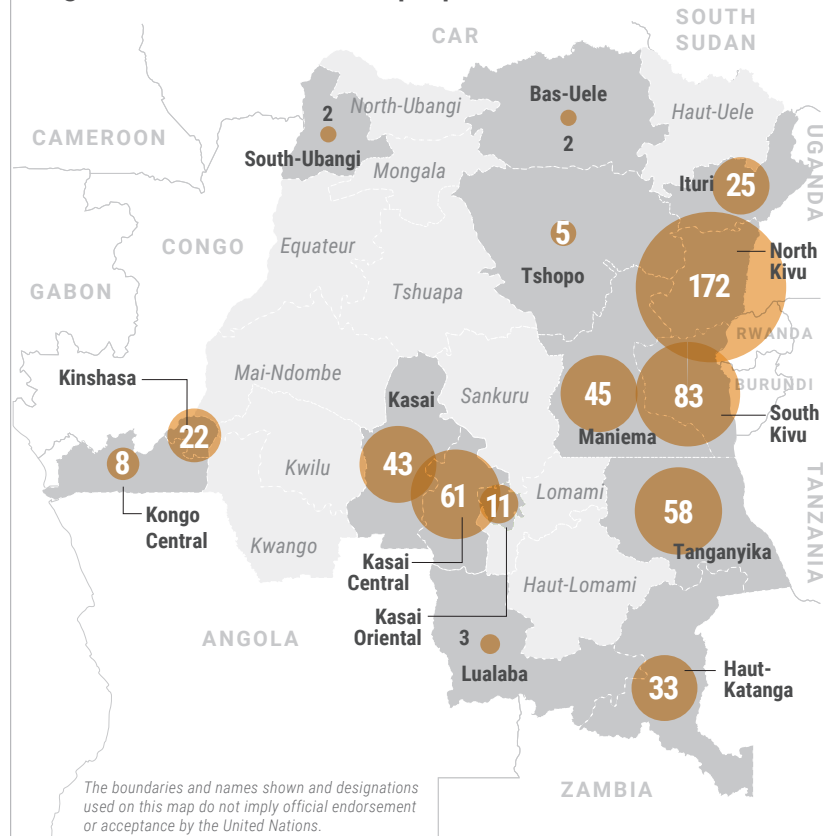
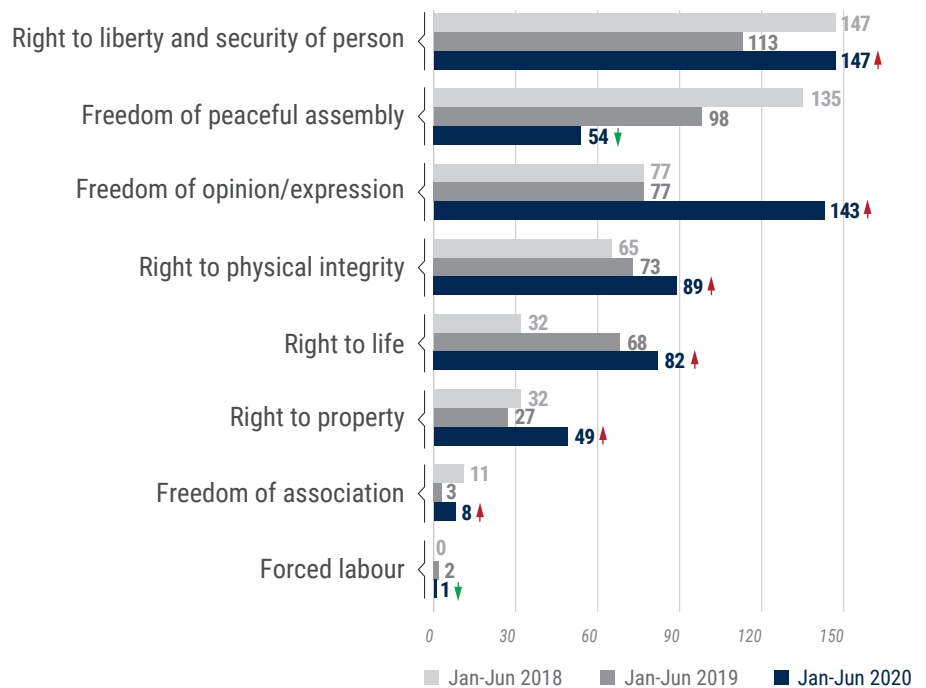
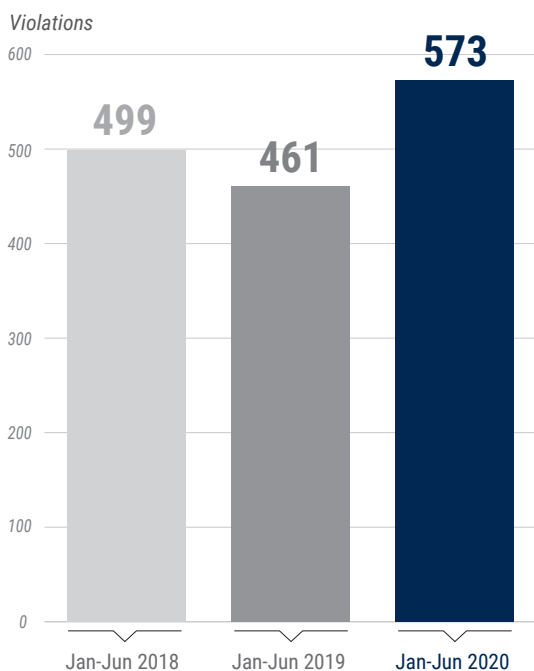


Figure 4. Evolution of restrictions to democratic space (first semesters only)
